

NCYC 2017



WHAT is NCYC? The National Catholic Youth Conference is a powerful, biennial, three-day experience of prayer, community, and empowerment for Catholic teenagers (of high school age) and their adult chaperones. More than 25,000 young people and their chaperones attended 2015 NCYC in Indianapolis.

WHEN is NCYC? NCYC is November 16 – 18, 2017. We will leave from one of the Lansing Area Churches (TBD) Thursday morning (Nov. 16) and return Sunday (Nov 19) afternoon.

WHERE is NCYC? NCYC will take place in Indianapolis Indiana at Lucas Oil Stadium (where the Indianapolis Colts play). We will stay at a local hotel at night.

WHO can go to NCYC? All those currently in 8th – 11th grade can go. It is for high schoolers so those in 12th grade will be in college during NCYC.

What is the Cost for NCYC? \$520.00 is the cost given to us by the Diocese. However, do to previous fundraising efforts as well as future efforts, your final cost will be \$250. Partial Scholarships Available. \$50.00 deposit due by June 1, 2017. This fee includes all transportation, a Diocese of Lansing T-Shirt for NCYC, conference fees, hotel fees, and all breakfast meals. It does not include lunch or dinner on Friday and Saturday. Final payment is due by September 1.

What else should I plan to Bring? You will want to bring between \$50 – \$70 dollars for meals on Friday and Saturday and potentially lunch on Sunday (5 meals). Clothes for 4 days, toiletries, good walking shoes, snacks for the bus ride, games/iPods for the bus ride, a camera, etc.
